FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION AND RURAL SOCIOLOGY Entry Requirements

Minimum Requirement

Candidates seeking admission into any of the programmes must have five credits in O'level, SSCE or NECO at not more than two sittings (subjects include: English, Mathematics/Physics, Chemistry, Agriculture/ Biology).

Entry Requirement:

In addition to the general requirement, candidates must have a first degree with a CGPA of 1.60 and above in an approved field of study by the Nigerian Institute of Animal Science (NIAS) from any University recognized by the Senate of the University of Calabar. Graduates from the following disciplines are also eligible to apply;

Entry Requirement:

In addition to the general requirement, candidates must have a good first degree with a second class (HONS) grade point of 3.00 (3/5) in an approved field of study by the Nigerian Institute of Animal Science (NIAS) from any University recognized by the Senate of the University of Calabar.

3. Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Programme

- o Ph.D. in Animal Nutrition & Biochemistry
- Ph.D. in Animal Production and Management (sub-specialization in cattle production, poultry production, micro- livestock production, small ruminant production)
- o Ph.D. in Animal Physiology

Entry Requirement

Students for Ph.D. Programme must have a good Master of Science (M.Sc.) degree in Animal Science discipline (i.e. CGPA of 3/4, 4/5 or 60%) from any University recognized by the Senate of the University of Calabar.

DEPARTMENT OF CROP SCIENCE

The following programmes leading to the award of PGD, M.Sc and Ph.D in Crop Science exist:

Entry Requirements

- a) O'Levels
 - i) West African School Certificate with passes at credit level in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and at least a pass in Physics.
 - ii) General Certificate of Education (GCE) with credit level passes at ordinary ('O') level in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and at least a pass in Physics.
 - iii) Senior Secondary School Certificate with credits in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and at least a pass in Physics.

b) Postgraduate Diploma

- i) Graduates who possess at least a third class in any field of Agriculture or related Science courses.
- ii) Applicants who hold Higher National Diploma (Upper Credit) in any field of Agriculture or related field of Science.

c) M.Sc Programme

- i) Candidates for the M.Sc programme must have a good first degree in Agriculture or related science course. A minimum of second class lower with CGPA of 3.00 is required on a 5 point scale or 2.75 on a 4 point scale.
- ii) Graduates with less than 2.75 or 3.00 but with a Postgraduate Diploma in Crop Science or related discipline with an average score of 60% or 3.00/5 cumulative average are eligible.

d) Ph.D Programme

Students for Ph.D programme must have a good Master of Science degree (M.Sc) with an average score of at least 60% or 3.00/4 or 4.00/5 in Agriculture or related discipline.

DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

- (iii) HND with not less than lower credit in Forestry and Wildlife, Agriculture, Fishery, Environmental Science, Botany, Zoology or related field of study from the University of Calabar or any institution recognized by the Senate of the University of Calabar

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B. Master of Science Degree Programme with Specialization in the following areas

Entry Requirements

- (i) 'O' Level Requirements, same as in A (i) above
- (ii) The CGPA of not less than 3.0/5 or 2.75/4 points scale. Candidates with Bachelor's Degree, with Third Class Honours from recognized Institutions and Upper Credit (60% average) at the PGD in a relevant field or candidates with HND at the Upper Credit, distinction level plus at least 60% at the PGD in a relevant field from a recognized institution will also be considered.

C. Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) with Specialization in the following areas:

Entry Requirements

(i) 'O' Level Entry Requirements as in A (i) above.

Candidate for the Ph.D Programme in Forestry and Wildlife must have a good Master's Degree in Forestry of Wildlife, with a cumulative grade point average of at least 60% (or a 'B' Grade) in the M.Sc. course/thesis work from the University of Calabar or any other University recognized by the Senate of the University of Calabar. Candidates with Master's Degree in relevant areas shall also be admitted into the Ph.D Forestry and Wildlife Programme.

The following programmes leading to the award of PGD, M.Sc and Ph.D in Soil Science exist:

Entry Requirements

a) O'levels

- (i) West African School Certificate with passes at Credit level in at least five subjects including; English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- (ii) General Certificate of Education (GCE) with credit level passes at ordinary 'O' level in at least five subjects including; English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- (iii) Senior Secondary School Certificate with credits in at least five subjects including; English Language, Mathematics, Agricultural Science or Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

b) Postgraduate Diploma

- (i) Graduate who posses at least a third class in any field of Agriculture or related science courses.
- (ii) Applicants who hold Higher National Diploma (Upper credit) in any field of Agriculture or related field of science

c) M.Sc. Programme

- (i) Students for their M.Sc programme must have a good first degree in Agriculture or related science course. A minimum of second class lower with CGPA of 3.00 is required on a 5 point scale or 2.75 on a 4 point scale.
- (ii) Graduate with less than 2.75 or 3.00 but with a Post Graduate Diploma in a Soil Science related discipline with an average score of 60% or 3.00 cumulative average.

d) Ph.D Programme

Students for Ph.D programme must have a good Master of Science Degree (M.Sc) with an average score of at least 60% in Agriculture or related discipline.

FACULTY OF ALLIED MEDICAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE

The Department is made up of four broad units of Chemical Pathology, Medical Microbiology and Parasitology, Haematology/Blood Group Serology and Histopathology. Post Graduate Programme is done in all the units except Histopathology.

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A. MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY/PARASITOLOGY

(a) Doctor of Philosophy

The programme is open to candidates with M.Sc. degree in Microbiology, Parasitology or Medical Laboratory Science, subject to a minimum CGPA of 3.00/4 or 4.00/5.

Area of Specialization: Each candidate will be admitted into a particular area of specialization chosen from the list below:

- (a) Clinical Bacteriology
- (b) Medical Parasitology
- (c) Medical Entomology
- (d) Public Health Microbiology
- (e) Medical Mycology

(b) Masters Degree (M.Sc.) Programme

(i) Graduates who hold at least a Second Class (Hons) Degree (with CGPA of 3.00/5 or 2.75/4) in Microbiology or any other related discipline from the University of Calabar or other institutions recognized by the Senate.

Areas of Research

- (a) Clinical Bacteriology
- (b) Medical Mycology
- (c) Medical Parasitology

(c) Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Microbiology and Parasitology (PGD)

The prospective candidate must be a University graduate with the following minimum requirements:

- (a) MBBCh or equivalent
- (b) B.Sc. (Hons) Degree in any Biology/Medical Laboratory Science related courses with Second Class Lower (CGPA not less than 2.5/4 or equivalent).

B. CHEMICAL PATHOLOGY UNIT

(a) Doctor of Philosophy

Areas of Specialization chosen from:

- (a) Immunology
- (b) Toxicology
- (c) Enzymology
- (d) Endocrinology
- (e) Nutrition

Admission Requirements

The programme is open to candidates with M.Sc. Degree in Chemical Pathology, Biochemistry or Medical Laboratory Science. For holders of suitable Bachelor's degrees, the admission will normally be to the M.Sc. programme in the first instance. Advancement from M.Sc. to Ph.D. programme will be allowed on recommendation of the Departmental College Graduate Committee to the Graduate School Board and after approval of the Senate.

(b) M.Sc. in Chemical Pathology Admission Requirements

This programme is open to candidates with Bachelor's Degree with first or second class honours in Physiology, Biochemistry, Medical Laboratory Technology and Chemical Pathology. Candidates with professional qualification in Human Medicine (M.B.B.S. etc), Dentistry (BDS, etc) or Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M) are eligible.

(c) Post Graduate Diploma in Chemical Pathology

Prospective candidates must be university graduate with the following minimum admission requirements:

- (i) Holders of the MBBCh degree or equivalent qualifications.
- (ii) Graduates of Biochemistry, Physiology, Microbiology and Haematology with at least Second Class Lower classification.
- (iii) Holders of the FIMLT Diploma in Chemical Pathology
- (iv) Holders of the AIMLT Diploma in Chemical Pathology with at least B average performance.
- (v) Those who do not meet the above qualification but have been actively involved in research may be considered for admission on their own merit.

Only candidates with a CGPA of 2.75 and above on a 4-point scale or 3.00 and above on a 5-point scale in the Diploma programme shall be eligible for admission to the M.Sc. programme.

C. HAEMATOLOGY/BLOOD GROUP SEROLOGY UNIT

(a) M.Sc. in Haematology/Blood Group Serology Admission Requirements:

Candidates for admission into the M.Sc. programme shall be:

- (i) Holders of BMLS or its equivalent
- (ii) Holders of MBBCh or its equivalent
- (iii) Holders of FMLSCN Diploma with dissertation in Haematology
- (iii) Holders of PGD in Haematology

(b) Post Graduate Diploma in Haematology/Blood Group Serology Admission Requirements

The Post Graduate Diploma is designed for Graduates whose degrees do not meet the entry requirements for the M.Sc. Degree work in the first instance or candidates who may not wish to do the required indepth work. The Programme would also provide good training for private practitioners wishing to upgrade their knowledge in Haematology and Blood Transfusion Science.

The candidates for admission into PGD programmes shall be:

- (i) Graduates of Medical Laboratory Science with at least a CGPA of 1.50.
- (ii) Holders of the MBBCh degree or its equivalent
- (iii) Holders of AMLSCN Diploma

DEPARTMENT OF NURSING SCIENCE

Minimum requirement

Candidates seeking admission into the programme must have

- i) Five credits in O'level, SSCE or NECO at not more than two sittings (subjects include: English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry & Biology)
- ii) A current, valid license of registration for practice from the Nursing and Midwifery Council of Nigeria (NMCN)

Entry requirement:

In addition to the general requirements, to be considered for admission into the Masters Degree programme, the candidate must possess:

- a) Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing: First or Second class Honors Degree from an accredited and recognized University with a CGPA not lower than 3.0 on a 5 point scale or 2.75 on a 4 point scale (in the Bachelor's programme).
- b) Also, the candidate must have submitted at least one (1) reference letter from his/her former Head of Department or Lecturer.
- c) A holder of Postgraduate diploma in Nursing may be admitted into the Masters' programme.
- d) Holders of Higher National Diploma (HND) with a minimum of Upper Credit or equivalent professional qualification may be admitted to the Master's Degree programme provided the candidate has Post Graduate diploma in Nursing.

DEPARTMENT OF RADIOGRAPHY & RADIOLOGICAL SCIENCE

1. M.Sc Programme

- Applicants must possess in the first instance, the requisite O'level requirements of 5 credits in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology and English Language to be considered eligible.
- Candidates must also possess evidence of completion of, or exemption from the mandatory National Youth Service Corps (NYSC).
- Submission of an acceptable research synopsis is a requisite condition.

2. Postgraduate Diploma in Radiography

Applications are invited into the post graduate diploma programme in Radiography.

Admission Requirements

- B.Sc degree with honours in Radiography with grade point average less than requirement for entry into the Master degree programmes (as obtained in the University of Calabar Graduate School Guidelines).
 Candidates with other relevant degrees/certificates e.g Diploma of the College of Radiographers (DCR) or Diploma of the Institute of Radiography (DIR) are acceptable for the PGD.
- Candidates with degree in Human Anatomy and Physics may be accepted for admission into the PGD programme.
- Applicants must possess in the first instance, the requisite O'level requirements of 5 credits in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology and English Language to be considered eligible.
- Candidates must also possess evidence of completion of, or exemption from the mandatory National Youth Service Corps (NYSC).

Admission Requirements

In addition to "O level" requirement for admission into the University of Calabar, the candidates for admission into the postgraduate diploma programme in Anatomy must have the following qualifications:

- c) NIST final certificate or equivalent in Anatomy and Histopathology at credit level or above.

2. M.Sc Programme in Anatomy Admission Requirements

The admission into the programme is open to candidates with first class honours or second class (hons) with cumulative grade point average not less than 3.00/5 in Anatomy of the University of Calabar or any other University offering B.Sc Anatomy as approved by the Senate of the University of Calabar. Candidates with qualification in Medicine and Surgery (MBBCh), Radiography and Dentistry (B.DS) are also eligible

provided their final result is equivalent of Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.25.

As in 2(a), (b), (c) and (d) above. Duration of programme: 24 months
