#### 2. Admission Requirements

##### (a) O' Level Subjects

Candidates must possess five O' Level credits in English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

For Medicine and Surgery, Nursing and Physiotherapy programmes, the five (5) O' Level credits (including Mathematics and English) must be obtained at one sitting and NABTEB is not acceptable.

##### (b) UTME Subjects

English Language, Biology, Chemistry and Physics

##### (c) Direct Entry

(i) Advanced Level GCE/Cambridge/IJMB/JUPEB at an acceptable grade level

(ii) Candidates with B. Sc. Second Class Upper Division in a related discipline can apply for the MB;BS programme.

(iii) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in 2(a) above.

(iv) For Nursing Science, candidates with RN/SRN plus five (5) O' level credits including English Language and Mathematics can apply and be admitted to 200 Level.

(v) For Physiotherapy, Public Health and Nursing, candidates with a degree in relevant discipline not less than 2nd Class Lower Division can apply.

(vi) For Medical Laboratory Sciences;

\*Candidates holding a minimum of three Advanced Level GCE/Cambridge/IJMB/JUPEB at Grade C pass in each of Biology, Chemistry, and Physics.

\*B.Sc. degree in relevant disciplines such as Zoology, Microbiology, Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, etc; as approved by Senate.

\*HND in relevant fields as approved by Senate

### **2. Admission Requirements**

#### **(a) O' Level Subjects**

Candidates must possess five O' Level credits to include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology/Agricultural Science/ Fisheries/Animal Husbandry, Chemistry and one of Physics, Geography, Economics, Civic Education, Food and Nutrition, Integrated Science and Information technology.

#### **Note:**

**(i) For Food Science and Technology and Nutrition and Dietetics, candidates must possess five O' Level credits to include Mathematics, English, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.**

**(ii) For Environmental Management and Control, candidates must possess five O'level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Biology/Agric. Science, Chemistry and one of Physics, Geography or Economics.**

**(b) UTME Subjects**

English Language, Chemistry, Biology & Physics/Mathematics

**(c) Direct Entry**

(i) NCE/ND or approved equivalent in relevant programmes.

(ii) At least two Advanced Level passes to include Chemistry and any one of the following: Biology/Botany, Zoology/Agricultural Science, Economics, Physics, Geography, and Sociology

(iii) IJMB, JUPEB at acceptable grade levels in relevant subjects

(iv) HND holders from a recognized Polytechnic with a minimum of Lower Credit.

(v) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in 2(a) above.

(vi) For Nutrition and Dietetics, candidates must possess: NCE/ND or approved equivalent in Food and Nutrition or be a Registered Nurse or approved equivalent in relevant fields.

**(C) FACULTY OF HUMANITIES (3 or 4 Year Programme)**

**1. General Entry Requirements**

(a) All applicants are required to have credits in at least five O' Level (5) subjects at SSCE, GCE, NECO, or approved equivalent.

(b) The five (5) credits must include English language and other specific departmental requirements.

(c) The five credits must be obtained at not more than two sittings.

(d) Candidates awaiting results may also apply.

**2. Department of English**

**(a) Degree Programme**

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O`Level credits to include English Language, Literature- in-English plus at least one other Arts subject.

**(c) Direct Entry**

(i) At least two Advanced Level Passes or equivalent in Literature and one other Arts subject.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB at acceptable grade level.

(iii) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O` Level requirements as stated in (2b) above.

**3. Department of History and International Studies**

**(a) Degree Programme**

B.A. History and International Studies

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O` Level Subjects**

The five O` Level Credits to include English Language, History or Government or Civic Education, plus at least two other Arts or Social Science subjects and any other subject.

**(c) Direct Entry**

(i) At least two Advanced Level Passes or equivalents in Government and any one other Arts or Social Science subject.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB/International Baccalaureate Certificate at acceptable grade levels.

(iii) NCE, ND or approved equivalents with at least Upper Credit in relevant fields

(iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O` Level requirements as stated in (3b) above.

**(d) UTME Subjects**

English Language, History/Government/Civic Education and any other two subjects from Arts and Social Sciences.

**4. Department of Communication and Performing Arts**

**(a) Degree Programmes**

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O` Level Subjects**

The five O` Level credits to include English Language, Literature-in-English and three other Arts or Social Science subjects.

**For Music the five O` Level Credits to include English Language plus three other Arts or Social Science subjects. A recognized certificate in Music from approved institution will be an advantage.**

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two Advanced Level passes in Literature and one other Arts subject.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB at acceptable grade levels.
- (iii) Diploma in Theatre Arts/Dramatic Arts from an accredited institution.
- (iv) For Music at least two Advanced Level passes or equivalents including Music. NCE/ND or approved equivalent in relevant subjects or ABRSM London Grade viii.
- (v) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O` Level requirements as stated in (4b) above.

### **5. Department of Philosophy and Religious Studies**

The five O` Level credits must include English Language, Christian/Islamic Religious Studies, two relevant Arts/Social Science subjects and any other one

##### **(a) O` Level Subjects**

Candidates must have five (5) O' Level credits to include: English Language, Literature in English and three other subjects obtained at not more than two sittings. A pass in Mathematics is acceptable.

**(b) UTME Subjects**

English Language, Literature-in-English and any two (2) other Arts or Social Science subjects.

**(E) FACULTY OF SCIENCE (3 or 4 Year Programme)**

**General Entry Requirements**

Candidates seeking admission to the Faculty of Science must possess a minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level Credit Passes in English Language and Mathematics in addition to specific departmental requirements.

**(1) Department of Biological Sciences**

**(a) Degree Programmes**

B.Sc. Microbiology

B.Sc. Pure and Applied Biology

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology and any one of Physics, Further Mathematics, Geography, Food and Nutrition.

**(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least any two GCE Advanced Level passes in Botany, Zoology, Biology and Chemistry.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or approved equivalent.
- (iii) ND holders must possess a minimum of Lower Credit
- (iv) HND holders must possess a minimum of Lower Credit for admission to 300 Level.
- (v) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in (1b) above.

**(2) Department of Biochemistry**

**(a) Degree Programme**

B.Sc. Biochemistry

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level credits to include: English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two GCE Advanced Level passes in Biology, Chemistry, and either Mathematics or Physics
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or approved equivalent at an acceptable grade level.
- (iii) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (2b) above.

### **(3) Department of Chemistry and Industrial Chemistry**

#### **(a) Degree Programmes**

B.Sc. Chemistry

B.Sc. Industrial Chemistr

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level subjects to include English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology and Physics.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two GCE Advanced Level passes in Chemistry and either Mathematics or Physics.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or approved equivalent.
- (iii) Holders of HND from a recognised Polytechnic with a minimum of Lower credit in Chemistry, Applied Chemistry or Industrial Chemistry and Laboratory Technology can be admitted to 300 Level.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in (3b) above.

### **(4) Department of Computer Science and Information Technology**

#### **(a) Degree Programme**

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level subjects to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics, and any two from Further Mathematics, Biology/Agricultural Science, Chemistry, Economics, Technical Drawing, Basic Electronics/Electronics, Computer Studies, and Data Processing.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) NCE/ND or approved equivalent with at least Merit and Upper Credit respectively in the relevant fields.
- (ii) IJMB, JUPEB, Cambridge Moderated School of Basic Studies, GCE Advanced Level or approved equivalents at acceptable grade levels in Mathematics and Physics
- (iii) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in (4b) above.
- (iv) All Direct Entry candidates are required to apply through JAMB.

### **(5) Department of Mathematics and Statistics**

#### **(a) Degree Programmes**

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

##### **(i) Mathematics**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics and any other two subjects from Chemistry, Biology/ Agricultural Science, Geography, Computer Studies, Economics, Further Mathematics and Technical Drawing.

##### **(ii) Statistics**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics and any other two subjects from Statistics, Chemistry, Biology/ Agricultural Science, Computer Studies, Geography, Economics, Further Mathematics and Technical Drawing.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**



- (i) At least two GCE Advanced Level passes to include Mathematics and any one of Biology, Chemistry, Economics, Statistics and Physics.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or approved equivalent at an acceptable grade level.
- (iii) For Statistics, a Diploma in Statistics from a recognized university is acceptable.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in (5b i & ii) above

**(d) UTME Subjects**

English Language, Mathematics and any other two relevant subjects.

**(6) Department of Physics and Solar Energy**

**(a) Degree Programme**

B.Sc. Physics

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level subjects to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics and any two from Chemistry, Biology/Agricultural Science, Geography, Technical Drawing, Further Mathematics and Food and Nutrition, Basic Electricity, Basic Electronics and Computer Studies.

**(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two GCE Advanced Level Passes in Mathematics and Physics. In exceptional cases, Physics and Chemistry may be considered.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or approved equivalent.
- (iii) HND holders from a recognised Polytechnic with a minimum of Lower Credits in Physics or Physics with Electronics or Electrical and Electronics Engineering may be admitted to 300 Level.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (6b) above.

**(F) FACULTY OF ENGINEERING (5 Year Programme)**

**General Entry Requirements**

Candidates seeking admission to the Faculty of Engineering must possess a minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level Credit Passes in English Language and Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, in addition to specific departmental requirements.

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and any relevant Science subject at not more than two sittings.

English Language, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry.

**(2) Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering**

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and any relevant Science subject at not more than two sittings.

**(c) UTME Subjects**

English Language, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry

**(G) FACULTY OF SOCIAL AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES (3 or 4 Year Programme)**

**General Entry Requirements**

Candidates seeking admission to the Faculty of Social and Management Sciences must possess a minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level Credit Passes to include English Language and Mathematics in addition to specific departmental requirements.

**(a) Degree Programmes**

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

#### **B.Sc. Accounting**

The five O' Level Credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Economics and one Social Science subject and any other subject.

#### **B.Sc. Banking & Finance**

The five O' Level Credits to include English Language and Mathematics, one Social Science subject and any other two subjects.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

(I) At least two Passes at GCE Advanced Level, to include Economics and any one of Government, Geography, Mathematics, Business Method and Economic History.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND/ATS of ICAN/NIM/NIMN/ANAN or approved equivalent.

(iii) Holders of HND in Banking and Finance, Accounting, Business Administration and other related disciplines from a recognized Polytechnic.

(iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' level requirements as stated in (1b) above.

#### **(2) Department of Business Administration**

##### **(a) Degree Programmes**

B.Sc. Business Administration

B.Sc. Industrial Relations and Personnel Management

### **Admission Requirements**

#### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level Credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Economics and any other two relevant Social Science Subjects which may include: Government/Geography/Civic Education, Commerce, Business Studies/Education and Financial Accounting/Book Keeping.

#### **(c) Direct Entry**

(i) At least two GCE Advanced Level passes in relevant subjects.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND/ATS of ICAN/NIM/NIMN/ANAN or approved equivalent.

(iii) Holders of HND in Business Administration, Accounting and other related disciplines from a recognized Polytechnic.

(iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (2b) above.

### **(3) Department of Economics**

#### **Admission Requirements**

##### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The Five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Economics, one social science subject from Geography, Government, History, Civic Education, Sociology, Psychology, and any other subject.

##### **(c) Direct Entry**

(i) At least two GCE Advanced Level passes which must include Economics, and any other subject from Government, Geography, History, Sociology, Psychology, Mathematics, and Further Mathematics.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or its approved equivalent at an acceptable grade level.

(iii) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (3b) above.

### **(4) Department of Mass Communication**

#### **(a) Degree Programme**

B.Sc. Mass Communication

#### **Admission Requirements**

##### **(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Literature-in-English and two other subjects in Arts, Social Sciences, Business and General subjects

##### **(c) Direct Entry**

(i) At least two Advanced Level passes in any Arts or Social Science subjects. This may include Commerce and Financial Accounting.

(ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or its approved equivalent.

- (iii) HND holders with Upper Credit in Mass Communication or related courses.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (4b) above.

**(5) Department of Political Science and Diplomatic Studies**

**(a) Degree Programmes**

B.Sc. Political Science

B.Sc. International Relations

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

Five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics, Government (or History) and any other two (2) subjects from Social Science general requirements.

**(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two Advanced Level passes to include History/ Government, Civics, Geography, Economics or equivalent in Social Science subjects approved by Senate of Bowen University.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or its approved equivalent
- (iii) HND holders with a minimum of Upper Credit from a recognized Polytechnic in Public Administration, Local Government Studies, and Political Economy.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (5b) above.

**(6) Department of Sociology**

**(a) Degree Programme**

B.Sc. Sociology

**Admission Requirements**

**(b) O' Level Subjects**

The five O' Level credits to include English Language, Mathematics and at least one from Economics, Geography, Government or History and any other two subjects at not more than two sittings in SSCE, NECO, GCE, or their equivalent.

**(c) Direct Entry**

- (i) At least two Advanced Level passes to include Sociology, Psychology, Economics, History or Government, Geography, and Religious Studies.
- (ii) IJMB/JUPEB/NCE/ND or its approved equivalent.
- (iii) HND holders with a minimum of Upper Credit from a recognized Polytechnic in approved Sociology related subjects.
- (iv) In addition, candidates must satisfy the O' Level requirements as stated in (6b) above.
