2. Make a close study of the upper skull of a cow or goat with its two horns in place.

ALTERNATIVE C
DRAWING FROM LIFE

3. A female model dressed in short blouse over a wrapper falls asleep on a mat lying sideways. She rests her head on the bent left arm and stretches her right arm on her right thigh. She bends the right leg slightly to the back.

Draw the model as posed.
